- Date: Saturday, October 9, 2010
- Time: 1:00 PM shotgun - Check-in: 12:00 - 12:30 (remember - range balls are included)
- You can sign up as a team (encouraged) or as an individual.
- Your partner does not need to be a member/attender/prospect of a Southern Baptist Church.
- No prizes at registration (towels, caps, coolers, etc. - like we do in the spring).
- No program - except to recognize winners and hand out prizes (short) .
- Very few door prizes, if any.
- No speaker.
- We will eat while the results are tallied up.
- Each team will be paired with another team from another church (we have to have some fellowship - no exceptions, so don't ask).
- It is open to men and women as well as youth (KSHSAA rules prohibit golf team students from receiving prizes).
- Yes a husband and wife can be a team, two women can be a team.
- Each player receives two mulligans.
- We also will not have as many hole prizes as we do in the spring tournament.
- Entry deadline of October 1, 2010 is pretty firm.
- Late entries will be accepted only on a case-by-case basis.
